
Carp Instructions

Gather the materials you will need :



Print the fish sheet(s) of your choice and begin assembly:

1. Cut out the body and two tails.

2. Pinch the body perpendicular to the mid-point of the line and cut with scissors or keep flat and cut with a precision knife. Precision is not critical as long as the slot is roughly centered on the fish!

3. Cut the heavier line on the body right behind the eyes and the slot near the tail end of the body.

4. At the cuts near the eyes, pull the cut edge near the eyes to overlap the body approximately to the lighter line, and tape/glue/staple. This makes the head three dimensional.


5. Tape/glue/staple the tails to each other. Both side Bs (unprinted) should be securedtogether, and both side As (printed sides) are exposed.

6. Insert the larger of the two tail side fins into the slot in the main body. Arrange the tail so the part inside the body up against a center lengthwise fold of the body and more or less parallel to the body, pinch body to tail near the fin, tape/glue/staple into place.

7. Softly fold out the fins on either side of the body.

8. Curve the tail to one side or the other, create a soft fold along the length of the tail parallel to the bottom of the body.

9. Your fish should now be able to sit upright on a flat surface.



Optional: For more saturated colors or a sturdier fish, use higher quality paper for color printing and heavy weight paper.
